

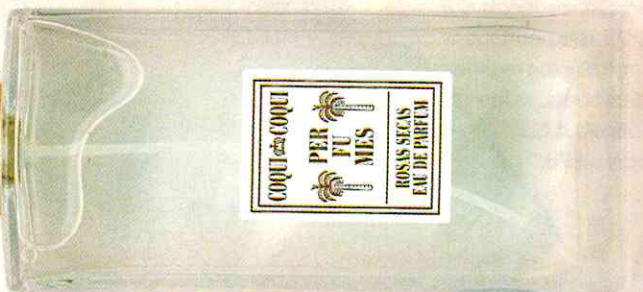
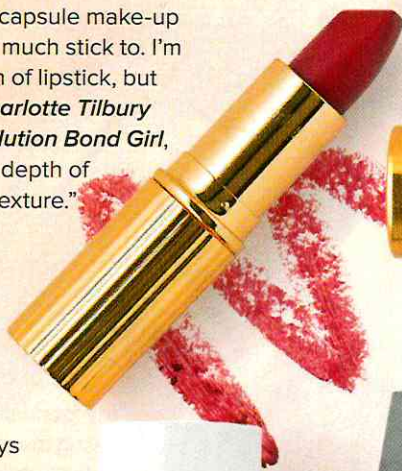


Beauty buyer Mia Fenwick
